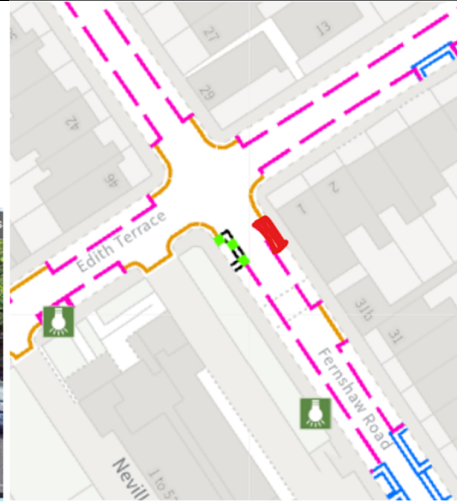
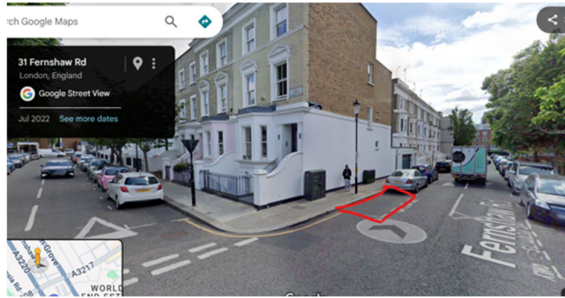


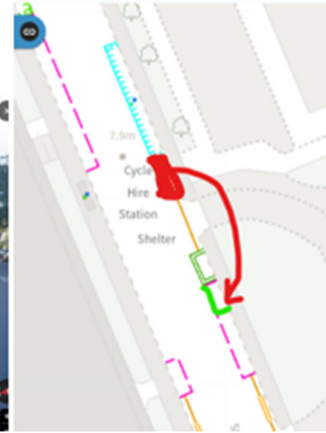
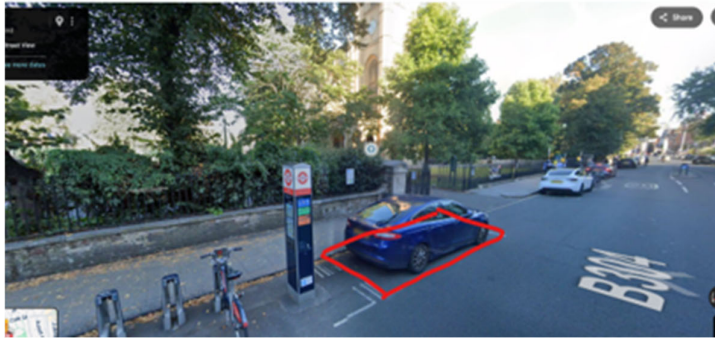
Traffic Management Order Proposed Changes

Proposal Reference Number – S619
Ward: Stanley
Street Fernshaw Road, Sydney Street, Elm Park Gardens, Gertrude Street.
Title of Proposal – Introduction of shared use electrical scooter and dockless bicycle bays
Existing Restriction – Residents’ parking, Pay-by-phone Visitor Parking.
Proposed new restriction
<p>A) Conversion of 5 metres (16ft) of residents’ parking outside the flank of No. 1 Edith Terrace, situated in Fernshaw Road, to a shared use electrical scooter and dockless bicycle bay. This is the northernmost 5 metres of the existing residents’ bay outside the flank wall of No. 1 Edith Terrace.</p> <p>B) Conversion of one Pay-by-Phone visitor parking bay opposite Royal Brompton Hospital on Sydney Street, to a shared use electrical scooter and dockless bicycle bay. This is the pay-by-phone bay immediately south of the Santander Bike Dock.</p> <p>C) Conversion of 5 metres (16ft) of residents’ parking outside St Luke’s Church on Sydney Street to a pay-by-phone bay (hours of control: Mon-Sat 8.30am-6.30pm Max stay 4 hours). This is the 5 metres immediately south of the existing pay-by-phone bay outside St Luke’s Church.</p> <p>D) Conversion of 5 metres (16ft) of residents’ parking outside the flank wall of No. 273 Fulham Road, situated in Elm Park Gardens to a shared use electrical scooter and dockless bicycle bay. This is the northernmost 5 metres of residents’ parking outside the flank wall of No. 273 Fulham Road.</p> <p>E) Conversion of 5 metres (16ft) of residents’ parking opposite No. 31 Gertrude Street to a shared use electrical scooter and dockless bicycle bay. This is the westernmost 5 metres of residents’ parking opposite No. 31 Gertrude Street.</p>
Reason for change
Proposals A, B, D and E are to meet increased demand for micromobility services and improve the distribution of the network of available parking bays. Proposal C is to relocate the Pay-by-phone bay we are proposing to remove in proposal B.

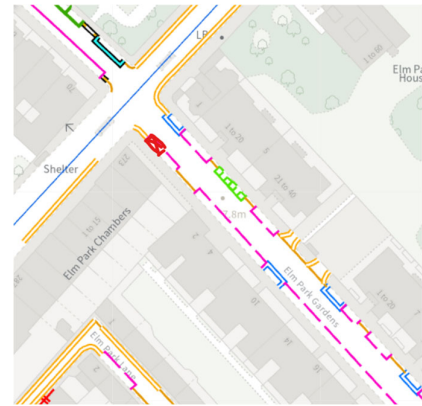

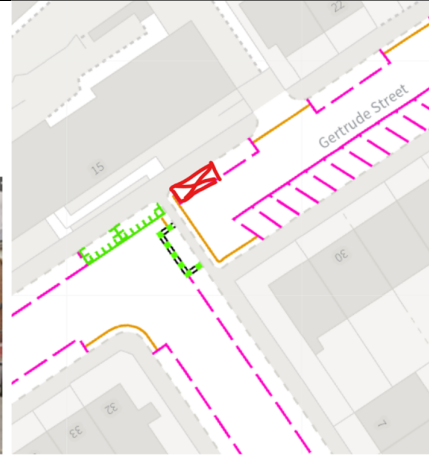
